Testing of referred clinical specimens was considered on the basis of request / referral received from / through State Surveillance Officer (SSO) of concerned State Integrated Disease Surveillance Programme (IDSP)/ any other health care facility affirming requirements of the case definitions.

- A single negative test result, particularly if this is from an upper respiratory tract specimen, does not exclude infection
- A positive test result is only tentative, and will be reconfirmed by retesting.
- Repeat sampling and testing of lower respiratory specimen is strongly recommended in severe or progressive disease. The repeat specimens may be considered after a gap of 2 to

4 days after the collection of the first specimen for additional testing if required.

- A positive alternate pathogen does not necessarily rule out either, as little is yet known about the role of confectons.
